Read

- i. Pray for the Spirit's leading, then read Acts 2:14-21.

Your story

- ii. If you feel able, share with your group when & how you first called on the name of the Lord. This will encourage people!

All people

- iii. Look at Acts 2:17-18. Discuss the significance of 'all people'.
- iv. What do you think the main meaning of 'prophecy' is here?
- v. If we have a dream or vision we think is from God, what should we do?

What, where, who, why, when

- vi. Focus now on Acts 2:21. In his sermon Jamie mentioned the what, where, who, why and when of the verse. Which of these stood out to you most? Why? Be specific.

Our responsibility

- vii. Read Romans 10:13-15. What is the main challenge to us in this passage?
- viii. Discuss how we can get better at what this passage is asking us to do.
