Read

- i. Pray for the Spirit's leading, then read Acts 2:41—42 & 1 John 1:1—10.

Discuss

- ii. Imagine you meet someone who has just become a Christian, who had previously never been to church or read the Bible. They've now started reading Acts. They've got to Acts 2:42 and they ask you "What is fellowship?" How would you explain it to them?
- iii. In 1 John 1:3 John says that "...our fellowship is with the Father and with his Son, Jesus Christ." Similarly, Paul says in 2 Cor. 13:14 that "...the fellowship of the Holy Spirit is with us all." Discuss what it means for us to have fellowship with God.
- iv. In your experience of church life, what things have really helped you experience good quality fellowship?
- v. If you were the Devil, how would you disrupt and damage fellowship at Argyle?
- vi. How are we doing at fellowship in Argyle? How can we improve/enhance our fellowship?

- vii. Pray against Satan disrupting & damaging fellowship at Argyle. Pray for God to improve & enhance our fellowship.
