

Acts 2:42-47; Hebrews 10:19-25 | Meet together

Study Questions from 23.04.2023 sermon

Discuss

- i. Read Acts 2:42—47 and Hebrews 10:19—25. In Acts, the believers met regularly with glad hearts but in Hebrews some had got into a habit of giving up meeting together. Why the change? What things cause Christians to give up meeting together?
- ii. Why should we meet together? Why not be a Christian alone? Jamie gave four reasons in the sermon. Can you remember them? Can you add any more?
- iii. In the sermon we considered how and where we can meet together. Think back over your Christian life. Share with your group your best times of meeting together with other Christians.
- iv. The atmosphere of the meetings either encourages or discourages folk from getting together. Discuss what kinds of atmosphere encourage and discourage meeting together.
- v. Spend some time in silent contemplation now, and consider these questions:
 - Is there anything I'm doing which might discourage other Christians from meeting together?
 - · What can I do to encourage Christians to meet together?
 - · Parents: how can you encourage your children?

vi. In your prayer time, ask God to bless our times of meeting together, and that those who have given up would come back.
