Read

Read 1 Cor. 1:1—3 & John 17:13—19 together.

Discuss

When we think about sanctification, we need to keep a number of things in mind. First and foremost, it is God who sanctifies us. The Holy Spirit alone has the amazing power to transform our hearts, conquer our idols, and cause us to delight in Jesus. We are not, however, passive in this process: We have a responsibility to cooperate with the Spirit and to contribute to our sanctification.

- v. Describe how God sanctifies us what sorts of things does He do in our lives?
 Describe how we contribute to our sanctification what sorts of things can we do?
 Include a specific personal example for each of the above questions.
- vi. What do you find hardest about Sanctification? Discuss what will motivate us and help us to be sanctified.
