





1 PETER 1:15–16

"But just as he who called you is holy, so be holy in all you do; for it is written: 'Be holy, because I am holy.'"









/ fundamental (core) meaning of 'holy'
is "different".

In the NT, holy has the technical meaning "different from the world" because "like the Lord."

[Implies something 'set apart' and therefore 'different (distinguished/ distinct)' - i.e. 'other,' because it is special to the Lord.]

2 Corinthians 7:1

Therefore, since we have these promises, dear friends, let us purify ourselves from everything that contaminates body and spirit, perfecting holiness out of reverence for God.

For God did not call us to be impure, but to live a holy life.




