Discuss

- i. Read Ephesians 5:21–24. The passage mentions wives submitting to husbands. Before we think about that, what is the Biblical context of submission in general?
- ii. Finish the following sentence, listing as many points as you can:
Biblical submission of the wife is not...
- iii. Look at Ephesians 5:22–24. Identify the key to correctly interpreting and understanding how wives should submit to their husbands, and discuss how this works out in practice for wives.
- iv. But why did Paul teach submission and headship? Recall the 3 reasons Jamie gave. Share with the group what you think of and feel about these reasons.
- v. Read Ephesians 5:25. What does this verse teach about the role of the husband as head of the wife & what might this mean in practice?
- vi. Read Ephesians 5:28 & 33. What do these verses teach about the role of the husband as head of the wife & what might this mean in practice?
- vii. If there are any husbands and wives in the group: share what you find hardest about your God-ordained roles in marriage.
