







Isaiah 50:6 – "I offered my back to those who beat me, my cheeks to those who pulled out my beard; I did not hide my face from mocking and spitting."


Isaiah 52:14 – "his appearance was so disfigured beyond that of any human being and his form marred beyond human likeness."


### 2) Jesus stepped forward in full authority (vs. 5-9)

### 3) Jesus stepped forward in full submission (vs. 10-14)


