- ii. Read John 6:37 and discuss how this verse applies to gay people.
- iii. Discuss why the (over)emphasis on sex in our culture (and on marriage in some churches) can make the gospel seem like bad news for gay people. What light does John 4:13—18 shed on this issue?
- iv. Read Matthew 13:44—46. How do these two parables apply to the question of whether or not the gospel is good news for gay people?
- v. Read Romans 12:5. Discuss how the gospel offers intimacy to gay people.
- vi. Read Matthew 16:24. How can gay celibate Christians uniquely bless God's kingdom and church?
