Read

- i. Read Genesis 2:2-3 & Exodus 20:8-11 to set the scene for this study.

Discuss

- ii. As you listened to the sermon on Sabbath worship, what stood out or resonated with you?
- iii. Re-read Genesis 2:2-3. Notice the phrase ‘...a holy Sabbath to the Lord’. What does ‘holy’ mean and what does ‘...to the Lord’ teach us about Sabbath Worship?
- iv. In what ways is it easy for your practice of Sabbath to become more of a day off than a day of worship?
- v. What ‘false gods’ are you tempted to worship, which, while they may be very good things (or not), pull you away from your holy centre in God?
- vi. Consider how we worship God. When we are together on Sunday, what things do you find enhance worship? How can we worship God individually on the Sabbath?
