- v. Look at Matthew 6:9. What is your primary view of God? Do you see him as your loving father? Or something else?
- vi. Look again at Matthew 6:9. What does it mean for us to 'hallow God's name' in prayer?
- vii. Look at Matthew 6:10. What does it mean to pray 'your kingdom come'?
- viii. The Lord's Prayer is the most famous example of a pre-made prayer. What other pre-made prayers are there and how can they help us?
