Discuss

- i. Look at v8. When Paul says we have been saved, what does he mean? What have we been saved from?
- ii. Look at Eph. 2:1—10 and count how many times Paul mentions grace. What is grace? Discuss and come up with a definition.
- iii. What are the two key things about grace which Paul brings out in v1-10? (Look at v3 and v8)
- iv. Read v9-10. Paul teaches that we are not saved by good works, but we are saved for good works. Commenting on this verse, R. Kent Hughes says *“Each of us has an eternally-designed job description that includes the task, the ability, and the place to serve.”* How do you feel about this? Excited? Daunted? Confused? Discuss how we might find what good works God has prepared in advance for us to do.
