

Ephesians 3:1-6 | Together

Study Questions from 18.05.2025 sermon

Discuss

- i. Read Eph. 3:1. When Paul says “For this reason...” what is he referring to? Why is he in prison and how does he feel about being imprisoned? (See Eph. 3:13)
- ii. Paul was willing to suffer for the sake of Jesus and the Gentile Christians. Discuss ways in which we might suffer for Jesus and for other Christians. How can we cultivate a heart which is willing to suffer for the sake of others?
- iii. Read Eph. 3:2. In this verse, Paul is telling the Ephesian Christians that God had entrusted him with the job of telling them all about God’s Grace. We are saved by grace (see Eph. 2:8) but how do we live by grace? Discuss what God’s grace means for us in everyday life and how to live in the atmosphere of God’s grace.
- iv. Read Eph. 3:3-6. In v6 Paul mentions three ‘togethers’. Make sure you understand what they mean, and discuss our togetherness at Argyle:
 - How can we be more together interculturally?
 - What do we especially need to be aware of to resist division, discord and disharmony?
