Study Questions from 15.06.2025 sermon

Discuss

- i. In v14 (and 3:1) Paul says “For this reason I kneel before the Father [and pray]...” He’s praying that what he’s written will affect their lives. Think back to what Paul has said in ch1-2. What are his big themes? Has anything particularly stood out to you?
- ii. Read v16-17a. Share how have you experienced the Spirit’s power ‘refurbishing’ your heart as a home fit for Christ to dwell.
- iii. Read v17b. Discuss practical things we can do to be rooted and established in love.
- iv. Read v18. Spend some time in silence meditating on the 4 dimensions of love. Ask the Spirit to bring to your mind a picture/explanation/example/insight to deepen your grasp of the love of Christ. Share with the group.
- v. Read v18-19. There are depths and dimensions of the love of God that are impossible to experience without surrounding ourselves with other followers of Jesus who are not like us. Identify one way that you can live this out practically in your life.
