Jeremiah's Complaint

- i. What is Jeremiah's complaint to God? Read v1-2 to find out.
- ii. Have you ever felt like Jeremiah? Knowing God is righteous and just, but also wondering what He is up to in your life and this world? If you feel able, share with your group.
- iii. How do we know it is OK for us to ask God our questions and come to him with our complaints?

God's Response

- iv. Read v5. God gives Jeremiah a race analogy. What does it mean and how does it apply to us? (Hint, see 1 Cor. 9:24-25)
- v. Read v7 & 14. In these verses, God responds to Jeremiah's question about why God allows the wicked to prosper. How might God's response have reassured Jeremiah. How does it reassure you?
- vi. Look at v15-16. What is surprising, and wonderful, about these verses? What do they tell us about God?
