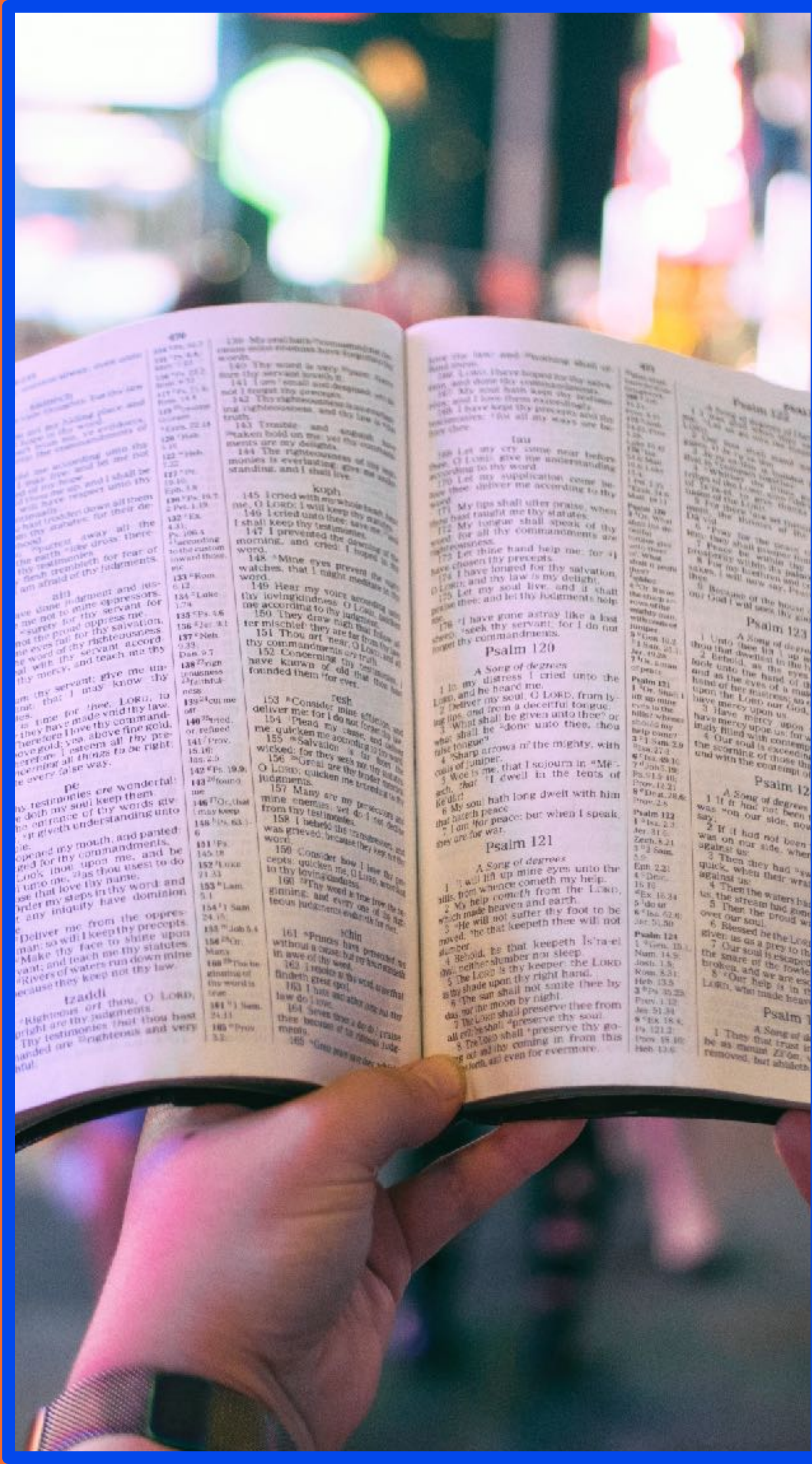

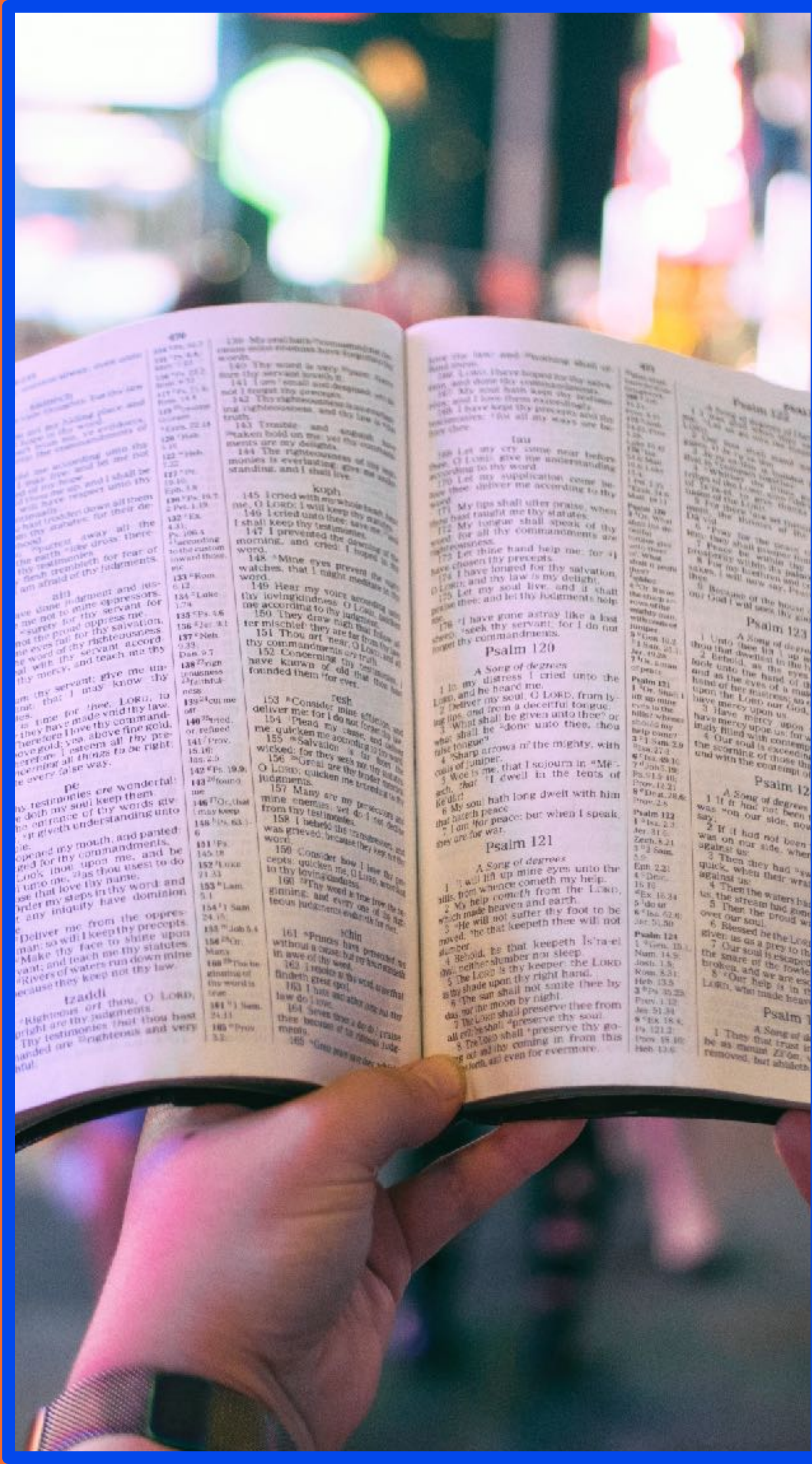


1. DEATH

Dead to the old life

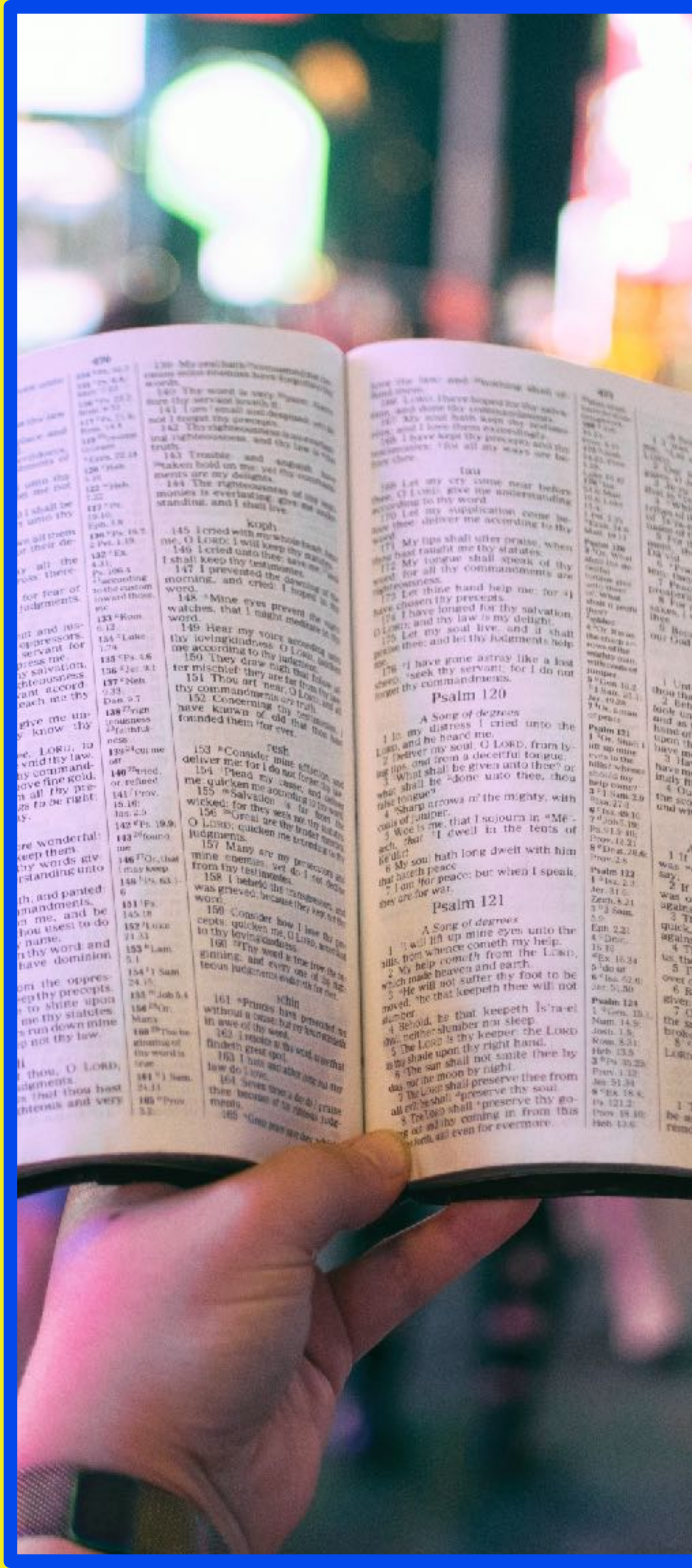
Romans 6:4

“For we know that our old self was crucified with him so that the body **ruled by sin** might be done away with, that we should **no longer be slaves to sin.**”



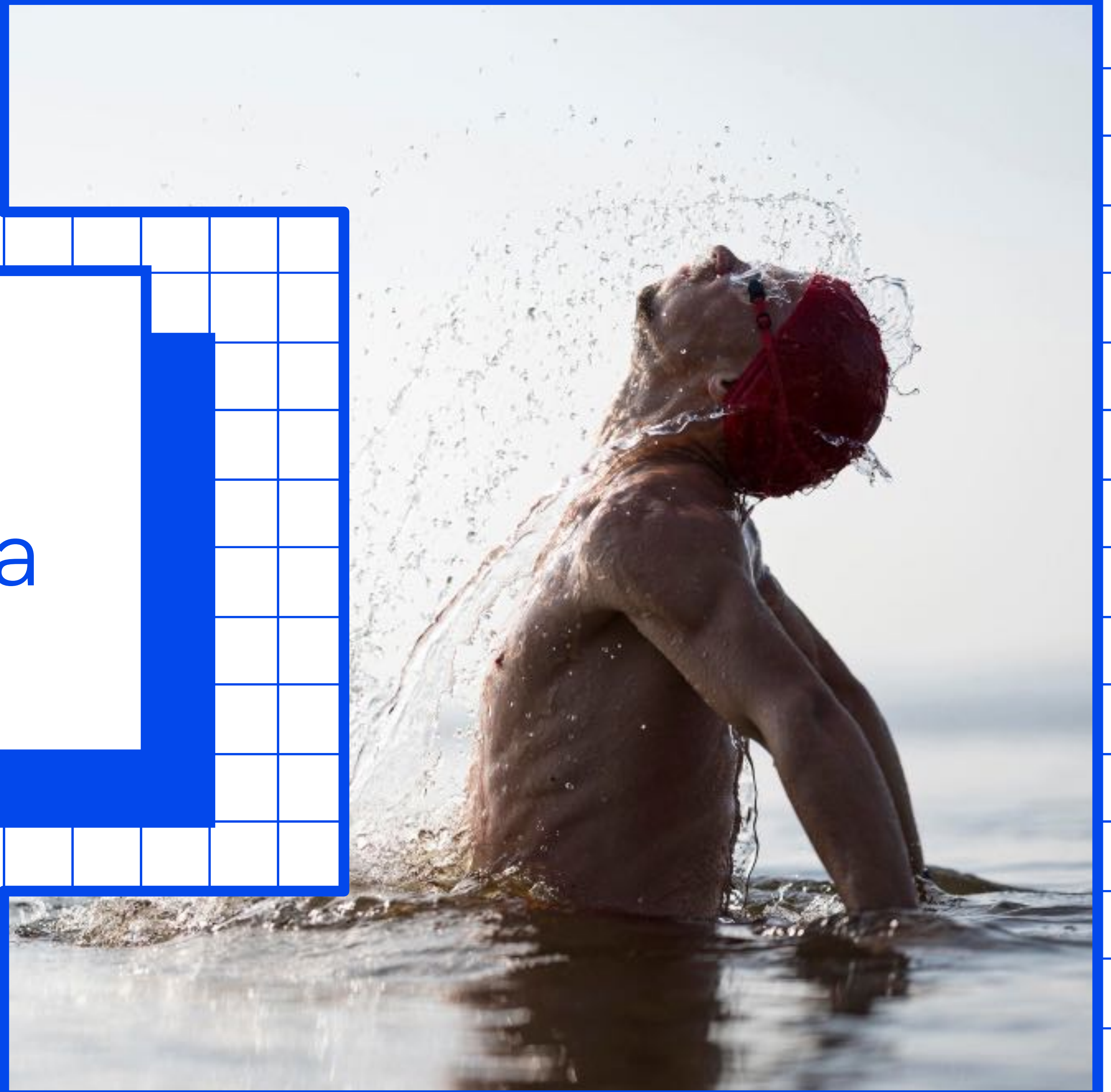

A New Love

God's love to me // My love to others

- ▶ He loved me and gave Himself for me! (Gal. 2:20)
- ▶ But God demonstrates his own love for us in this:
While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.
(Rom. 5:8)
- ▶ Love one another deeply, from the heart.
(1 Pet. 1:22)



A New Identity

God's Spirit in me // A new family

- ▶ And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another advocate to help you and be with you for ever – the Spirit of truth... you know him, for he lives with you and will be in you. (Jn. 14:16–17)
- ▶ See what great love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God! (1 Jn. 3:1)



A New Significance

I am not worthless, inadequate, helpless, or hopeless. In Christ I am significant.

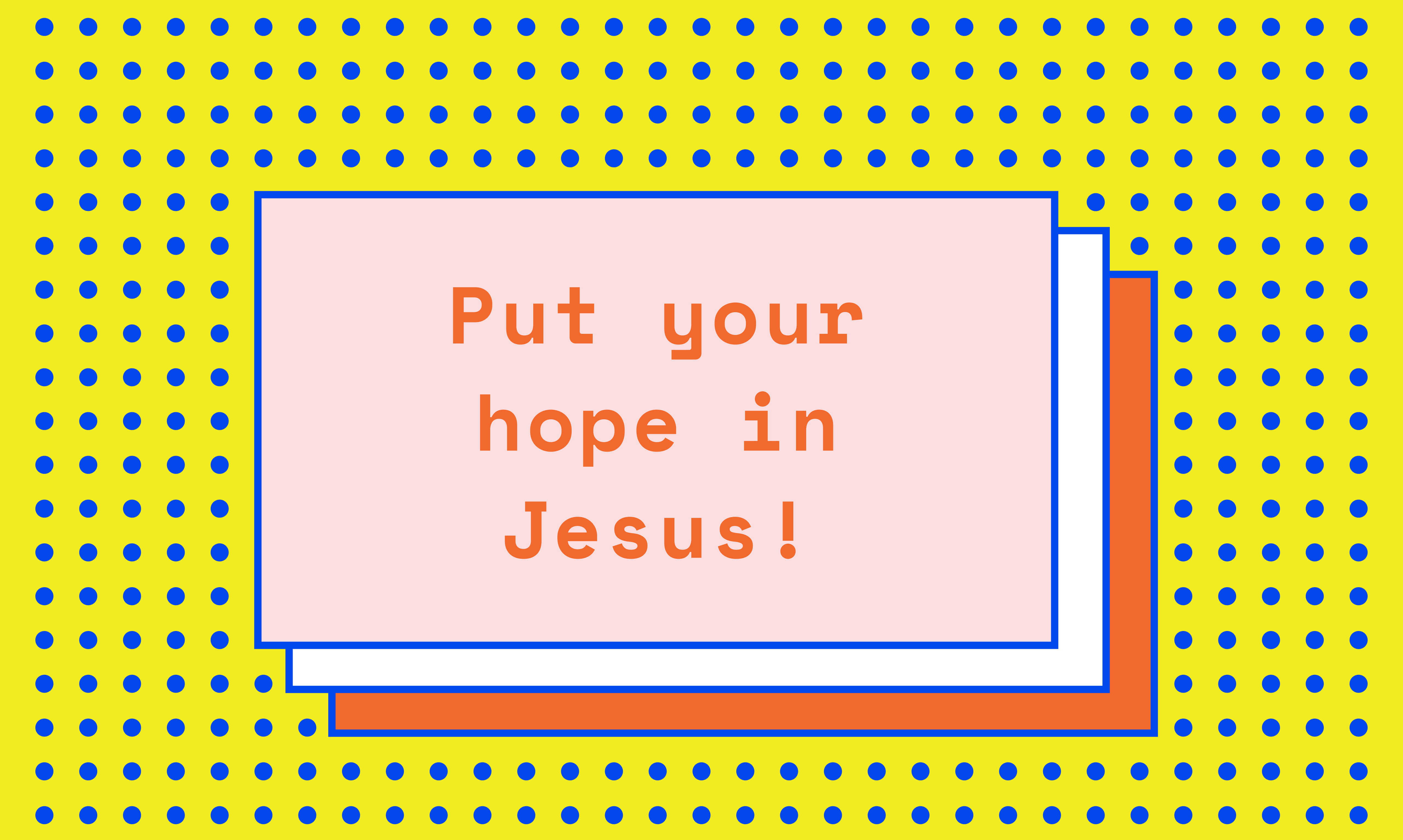
- ▶ I matter, because I matter to God (Psalm 139:13—18)

- ▶ I am God's treasured possession (Deuteronomy 7:6—8)



A New Hope

I no longer put my hope in humans, politics, money or anything else. I put my hope in God:

- ▶ Why, my soul, are you downcast? Why so disturbed within me? Put your hope in God, for I will yet praise him, my Saviour and my God. (Psalm 42:11)
- ▶ We have this hope as an anchor for the soul, firm and secure. (Heb. 6:19)
