







### A New Love

God's love to me // My love to others

- He loved me and gave Himself for me! (Gal. 2:20)
- ► But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us. (Rom. 5:8)
- ► Love one another deeply, from the heart. (1 Pet. 1:22)



# A New Identity

#### God's Spirit in me // A new family

- ► And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another advocate to help you and be with you for ever the Spirit of truth... you know him, for he lives with you and will be in you. (Jn. 14:16–17)
- ► See what great love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God! (1 Jn. 3:1)



## A New Significance

I am not worthless, inadequate, helpless, or hopeless. In Christ I am significant.

- ► I matter, because I matter to God (Psalm 139:13—18)
- ► I have value and worth because I am made by God in His image (Genesis 1:26—27)
- ► I am God's treasured possession (Deuteronomy 7:6—8)



# A New Hope
