Discuss

- i. Have you ever been in an environment where there were fights and quarrels? Has this ever happened in church, in your experience?
- ii. In the churches James was writing to there were fights and quarrels (v1), killing and coveting (v2) and slander and judging (v11-12). Look at v1—3. Discuss the cause(s) of all this conflict. Do you see this cause in yourself?
- iii. Read v4. Why does James call the Christians he is writing to “adulterous people”? In what ways might we be friends with the world?
- iv. Is there any hope and help for us in our struggle with our desires which battle within us? Yes! Grace. Read v6. What is grace and how do we get more of it?
- v. Because of God’s grace, he gives us promises. Read v7—10 and identify these promises and then share which you find most precious and why.
