

Study Questions - The Worship in Heaven

John 4:19-26; Revelation 4:1-11

When the Bible talks about worship it means two things: whole life surrender to God and a call to specific acts of worship. We are focussing on the latter in this study.

- Look at Revelation 4:1-6. What does v5 tell us about the significance of the Holy Spirit in worship? (Hint 1: what do blazing lamps do? Hint 2: See 1 Corinthians 2:13)
- What does the sea in Rev. 4:6 teach us about worship?
- What verses in Rev. 4:1-11 tell us that true worship is completely God-centred? How can we make worship at Argyle completely God-centred? How might we (unwittingly) make it human-centred?
- Rev. 4:5 shows us that true worship should be wholly Spirit led. So how do we involve him more in worship?
- What verses in Rev. 4:1-11 tell us that true worship is endlessly enjoyable? Has your experience of worship been enjoyable? Discuss what makes worship more/less enjoyable.
- What verses in Rev. 4:1-11 show that true worship is unashamedly extravagant? How did David demonstrate unashamed extravagance in worship? Discuss how we can do the same in our worship at Argyle?
