



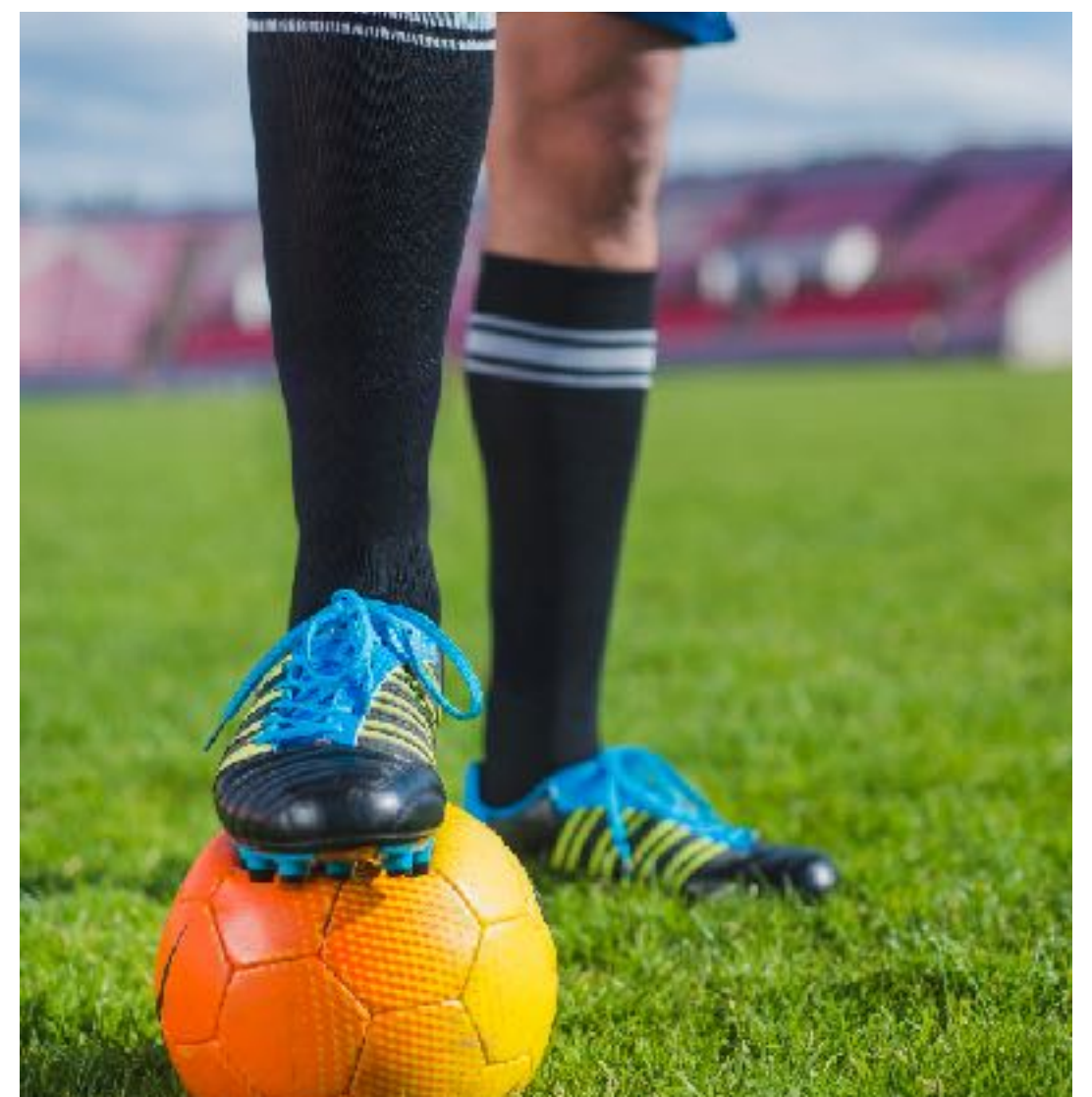
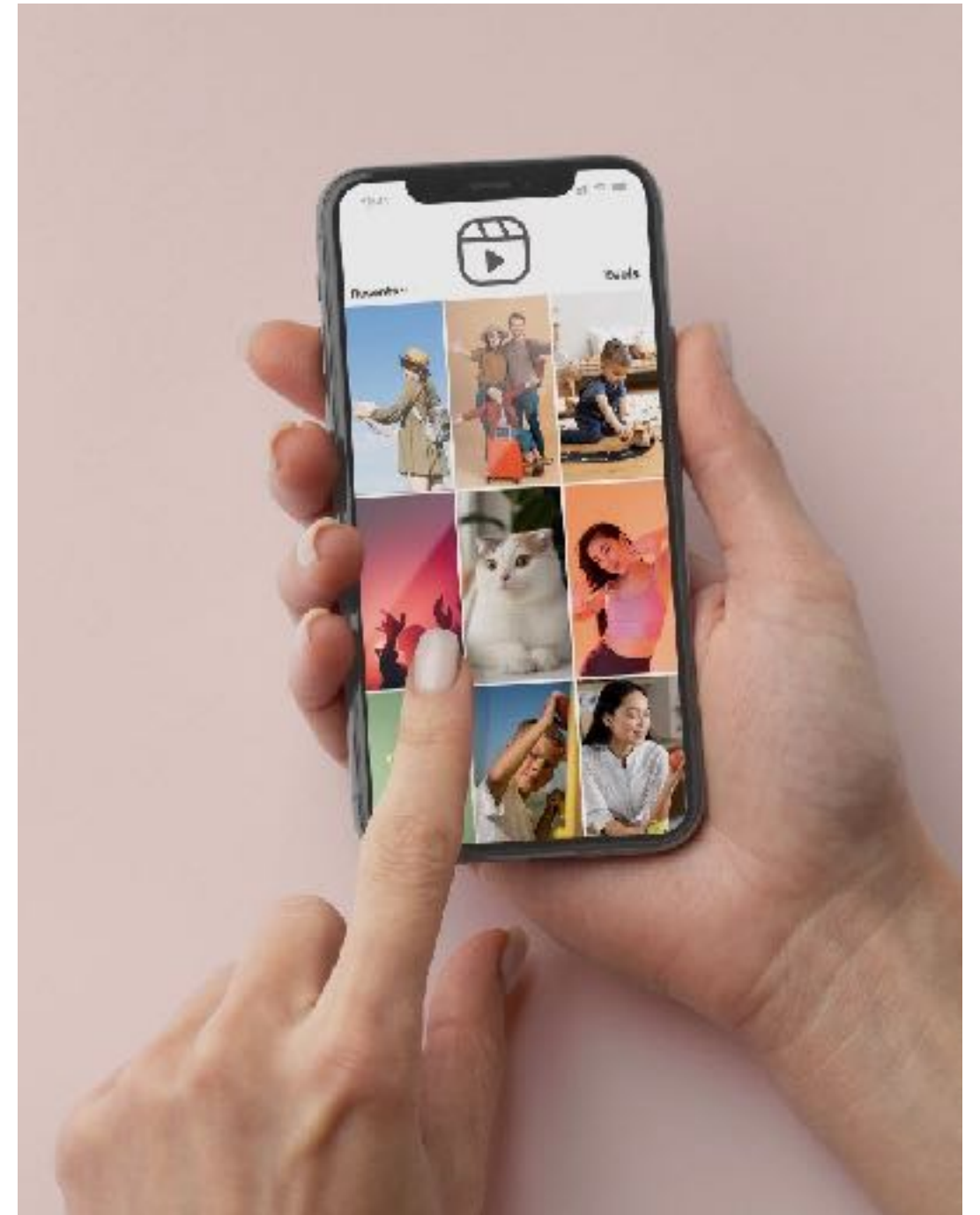

# WORSHIP

“Worship means to give worth or value to something. It expresses what we find most valuable or satisfying.”



## Why should worship be Spirit-led?

## Because the Spirit brings revelation

“<sup>10</sup> God has **revealed** [His wisdom & the gospel] to us by his Spirit.

<sup>12</sup> What we have received is not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, **so that we may understand** what God has freely given us.

<sup>13</sup> This is what we speak, not in words taught us by human wisdom but in words taught by the Spirit, **explaining spiritual realities** with Spirit-taught words.” 1 Cor. 2:10, 12-13



## Why should worship be Spirit-led?



## Because of what Jesus says

“<sup>23</sup> Yet a time is coming and has now come when the true worshippers will worship the Father **in the Spirit** and in truth, for they are the kind of worshippers the Father seeks. <sup>24</sup> God is spirit, and his worshippers must worship **in the Spirit** and in truth.” John 4:23-24



## REVELATION 4:2b-5, 10a

“<sup>2b</sup> There was a throne in heaven with someone sitting on it.  
<sup>3</sup> And the one who sat there had the appearance of jasper and ruby. A rainbow that shone like an emerald encircled the throne. <sup>4</sup> Surrounding the throne were twenty-four other thrones, and seated on them were twenty-four elders. They were dressed in white and had crowns of gold on their heads. <sup>5</sup> From the throne came flashes of lightning, rumblings and peals of thunder. **In front of the throne, seven lamps were blazing. These are the seven spirits of God.** <sup>10a</sup> the twenty-four elders fall down before him who sits on the throne and worship him who lives for ever and ever.”
