Study Questions from 12.07.2026 sermon

Discuss

- i. Have you ever had a particularly enjoyable worship experience which stands out in your memory? Share with your group.
- ii. Read Revelation 4:6b-8. Do you think the four living creatures are bored of worshipping God? Why/why not?
- iii. Read Psalm 147:1 which shows us that praising God should be enjoyable and joy-filled. Discuss why praise is "good, pleasant and fitting."
- iv. In the rest of Psalm 147, we sense the Psalmist enjoying himself - experiencing heartfelt satisfaction - as he puts pen to paper and writes down what God has done, celebrating with poetic lines of praise. Look at the Psalm. Do any verses particularly resonate with you and give you joy? Why? Share with your group.
- v. Read Exodus 15:20-21. What primarily motivates Miriam's praise? Discuss how her joyful worship relates to us and our motivations to worship; both personally and as we gather.
