# Jesus' Passion Week:

- Friday morning – Crucifixion
- Saturday - Nothing (body in the tomb)
- Sunday morning – Resurrection and early appearances
- Sunday afternoon/early evening - Emmaus Road

- It was an easy day's walking.
- There are several Roman routes between Jerusalem and Emmaus

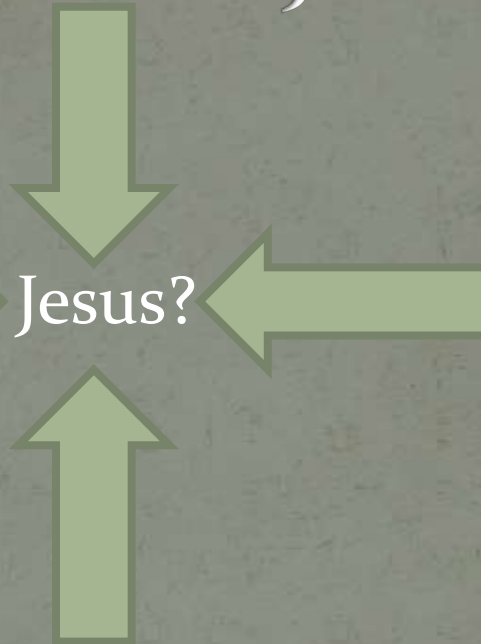
# *'Moses and all the Prophets'* (v. 27)

- Summary phrase for OT
- Three OT sections
- Alternatively:
  - *'The Law and the Prophets'* (12 x in NT)
  - *'Scripture'* or *'The Scriptures'* (v. 27, 32, 45)
  - *'Moses the Prophets and the Psalms'* (v. 44)
- *'all... concerning himself'* (v.27)



# 'All' OT Scriptures point to Jesus

- What in the OT
  - Key texts
  - Themes
  - Pictures
  - Longings
  - Unfulfilled desires

# Delicious Irony



IRONY

- Vs 21
  - *'...but we had hoped that he was the one who was going to redeem Israel.'*
- Vs 24
  - *'...but they did not see Jesus.'*



# 'Opened'

- What was opened?
  - Eyes (v. 31)
  - Scriptures (v. 32)
  - Minds and hearts (v. 32, 45)
- Passive
- By Jesus

# The Risen Christ

- Resurrection from the dead:
  - Unexpected
  - Impossible
  - Amazing
  - Central
  - Evidenced
