What's it like being in a battle or living through a war?

Are we really in a battle – or is it a long-lasting war?

Are we really in a battle – or is it a long-lasting war?

- We may think we're not in a war.
- We may take the war lightly think it's just having fun.
- We may think we can fight spiritual forces in our own strength. Jude 8-10 warns us not to.

On the strength of their dreams these ungodly people pollute their own bodies, reject authority and heap abuse on celestial beings. But even the archangel Michael, when he was disputing with the devil about the body of Moses, did not himself dare to condemn him for slander but said, 'The Lord rebuke you!' Yet these people slander whatever they do not understand, and the very things they do understand by instinct - as irrational animals do – will destroy them.

Jude 8-10 (NIV)

The REAL war

- Be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power.
- Put on the full armour ...
- ... so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes.
- For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, ...
- ... but against the rulers, .. authorities, .. powers of this dark world ...
- ... and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms.

Ephesians 6.10-12 (NIV)

We take spiritual forces seriously – but we're not afraid of them. Why not?

- We have weapons for defence and offence like the Roman soldier
- We belong to a disciplined, Holy Spirit-led body like the Roman legion
- We have an always-victorious general far superior to Julius Caesar

The Roman soldier – equipped and disciplined The Roman legion – united and versatile

Armour of God – Ephesians 6:13-17

- Helmet of Salvation Ephesians 6:17
- Breastplate of Righteousness Ephesians 6:14
- Belt of Truth Ephesians 6:14
- Shield of Faith Ephesians 6:16
- Sword of the Spirit Ephesians 6:17
- Feet of Peace Ephesians 6:15

Therefore put on the whole armour of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything, to stand.
