- Jesus is the Son of God - "I am" *Ex3 v1-14*
- Jesus is "The very image of God" *Col 1 v 15*
- Jesus is the "All-sufficient Messiah"

"All-sufficient Messiah"

- 'The Woman at the Well' - Humanity

- We are made in the image of God Gen1 v26&27
- We are made to rule Gen3 v1-14
- We can believe and we can have life

"All-sufficient Messiah"

- *'The Woman at the Well'* - Jesus rules
- John the Baptist was *counter cultural* in Jerusalem *John 3 v 36*
- Jesus had a choice to make *John 4 v 4*
- Jesus chose the time & place to meet *John 21 v6*

"All-sufficient Messiah"

- 'The Woman at the Well' - 3 steps to belief
 - She was intrigued - Jesus is counter cultural in Samaria
 - 'A Prophet' - Jesus talks of *living water* & her private life *John 4v19*
 - 'The Messiah' - Jesus says "I am he" *John 4 v 26*
 - Steps to Jesus - Just like Nicodemus *John 3* & the Blind Man *Mark 8*

"All-sufficient Messiah"

- 'The Woman at the Well' - the results
- Sin taken away - 'the jar' *John 4 v 28*
- Gospel preached - woman witnessed & people listened *John 4 v29&41*
- Jesus revealed as truly human (v6) & truly divine (v26)
- Jesus is the All-sufficient Messiah
