THE EXPECTED KING

Matthew 21:1-11

1. What Kind of Messiah?

<u>a. The expectation</u> – based on Gen.49:10; 2Sam.7:12-16; Ps.2,72,110; Is.11:1-10; Zech.9:9,10 etc.

The Messiah would:-

- 1. Liberate Israel from the Romans
- 2. Restore Israel to greatness under David's son

b. The Reality

Jesus comes as a very different sort of King:-

- 1. A <u>servant</u> King comes humbly to serve v.5 The crowd is unsure of him v.10; Mt.16:20
- 2. The <u>suffering</u> King conquering through his death. The disciples don't grasp this–Mk.8:27-32

2. What Sort of Salvation? -v.9; Ps.118:25

- a. The expectation
 - political and military freedom
 - recapturing former glory
- b. The <u>reality</u> Jesus came to defeat our 3 greatest enemies:-
 - power of sin bearing the penalty for sin
 - all-embracing power of death defeated death
 - Satan stripped him of his power Col.2:15

Freedom not just for Jews but all nations

3. Our Response to God's Messiah

- a. <u>Jews</u> still praying for the Messiah to come
- b. Gentiles unimpressed by the Cross & Resurrection
- c. Christians we are called to:-
 - 1. Trust him
 - 2. Follow in his footsteps Lk.9:23
 - 3. Proclaim him as God's Messiah
