Read Numbers 13

Introduction - What do you see?

- i. If you have the means, show the two pictures (should be on Argyle website in sermons section) and the video <https://youtu.be/vJG698U2Mvo> to any group members who were not at the sermon.
- ii. Why do we see different things when we look at the same picture/video?

Seeing the land

- iii. In v18 Moses tells the spies to see the land. They go out and come back to give their reports. What did they see and what effect did it have on them? Why this effect?
- iv. What verses tell us the 11 spies were most probably exaggerating? (see also Deut. 1:28) Why were they doing this?
- v. Caleb saw differently. Read out what he says in v30. Where did he get his confidence from?

Bible characters who saw

- vi. Jamie listed 5 Bible characters (inc. Caleb) who saw God (or his power) and were greatly affected by what they saw. Can you remember them and their reactions? Why were they confident (or not)?

How to be confident for 2019

- vii. Deuteronomy 1:29—31 gives us a 3 step process to gain confidence. Read the passage then identify and discuss these 3 steps.
- viii. What are you most scared of in 2019? What do you anticipate with most foreboding? Share with your group and then spend some time praying for one another about these things.
