### **Our new vision**

- v. How and why does Christ's love carry us so wide, long, high and deep, far beyond all the scientific formulas, philosophical principles and theological debates?

- vi. Why is it so crucial for us to always grow in Christ's Love? (Three reasons were mentioned in the sermon, involving temperature, capacity and type.)

  - iv. Asking people to pray for you
  - v. Praying for yourself
