Study Questions from 02.02.2020 sermon

Why?

- i. Argyle's new vision is: 'Always Growing in Christ's love, strength and new life'. Why is it so important to be always growing in Christ's strength? (8 reasons were given in the sermon)

How?

- ii. How can we be always growing in Christ's strength? Look up and read out Ps. 121:1-2a; Eph. 6:10; Eph. 3:16; Is. 41:10 to find out.
- iii. Read Luke 22:41—44. Reflect on this passage. What does it teach us about God giving us strength? (Think about the means God might use to strengthen us in our hour of need)
- iv. Share with your group a time when God has given you strength just when you needed it most.

- v. What is the simple process we must follow to grow in Christ's strength, and although simple, why might we find it hard?
- vi. Read 2 Cor. 12:9—10. Discuss how this passage relates to us growing in strength. How might our strength cause us weakness? How might our weakness give us strength?
